2. The petitioner has filed the instant application for the following relief(s):

“A. For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction commanding the Respondents to include the sanctioned posts of Assistant Engineer (Electrical) in the Health Department and Urban



Development and Housing Department, among others, in Advertisement No. 31/2025 issued by the Bihar Public Service Commission, to the extent such vacancies have been sanctioned and remain unfilled by regular appointment.

B. For any other order(s), direction(s) as deemed fit by this Hon'ble Court in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”
