learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection registered under Sections 147, 148, 441 , 325 , 441 , 337, 338 , 323, 307, 353, 332, 333 , 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code .

3 . As per prosecution case , on the alleged date and time of occurrence , informant got an information regarding road accident due to which road was blocked and upon the said information , informant along with other police official arrived at the place of occurrence and tried to pacify the matter, in the



meantime , all the F.I.R. named accused persons including these petitioners pelted stones on the police party due to which, some of the police personnel sustained injuries.

4. In view of nature of accusation , and the fact that some police personnel sustained injury , this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioners is rejected.
