APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 30(a), 36 and 41(2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Sections 111(i) (ii), 338, 336(3) of BNS.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from a car, altogether 79.02 liters of illicit liquor was recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. He has been falsely implicated in this case. He has got no concern with the alleged liquor and also he has no knowledge about the recovery



of liquor. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 31.07.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of regular bail and submitted that petitioner is having criminal antecedent of one case.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 383 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge Excise- I, Purnea **with a condition that petitioner will not indulge in similar nature of offences in future.**
