in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No. 133 of 2021,
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307/34 of
IPC read with Section 27 of Arms Act.

Mr. Shailendra Kumar, has submitted that the processes under
Sections 82 and 83 of the Cr.P.C. has been issued, as such, the
