2 24-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Sasaram (T) P.S. Case No. 468 of 2025 instituted for the offence
under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 316(2) & 111 of the Bharatiya
Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case is that on 17.06.2025, police
received secret information about a gang cheating passengers
near Sasaram Railway Station by selling duplicate gold
jewellery. During the raid, five persons tried to flee, out of



which two – Ajmal Akhtar and Jay Kumar (petitioner) – were apprehended with duplicate rings and clothes, while three escaped.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 18.06.2025. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Petitioner has become the victim of the circumstances as he went to police station only to catch the train for Mughalsarai. There is compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and nature of accusation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties



of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court
below/concerned Court in connection with Sasaram (T) P.S.
Case No. 468 of 2025.
