ORAL ORDER

2 25-09-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Complaint Case No. 1612C/2024 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegation is of subjecting the complainant to
various sorts of torture due to non-fulfillment of demand of
dowry.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and she has falsely been implicated in the case. Petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and she is living separately and she has no concern with her son and daughter in law in any manner. She has clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and she is living separately and she has no concern with the affairs of her son and daughter-in-law in any manner, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District Court where the case is pending in connection with Complaint Case No. 1612C/2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C / 482(2) BNSS.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner is involved in some other cases as what has been stated in Para-



3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
