APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Marhowrah P.S. Case No. 513 of 2024 dated 12.09.2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 80(2), 238, 61(2) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have committed murder of the daughter of the informant and disappeared the dead body of the deceased due to non-fulfillment of demand of a motorcycle and chain as dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner, who is



the brother-in-law (Bhaisur) of the deceased. It is further submitted that the husband of the deceased is in jail/custody. The petitioner neither demanded any dowry nor tortured the deceased. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. As per para-4 of the bail petition, the petitioner is in custody in this case since 07.07.2025 and as per para-1 and 2 of the impugned order dated 12.08.2025, the petitioner is in custody since 07.06.2025 and 07.04.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Marhowrah P.S. Case No. 513 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
