2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Daudpur P.S. Case No. 162 of 2021, registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 420 and 379 of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. Considering the nature of allegation made in the
FIR, as well as, the criminal antecedent of the petitioner, I am
not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on pre-arrest bail.

4. However, the petitioner, if so advised, may



surrender before the learned District Court and seek regular bail and the learned District Court is directed to consider the regular bail of the petitioner same day, in accordance with law.

5. Accordingly, the present bail application stands disposed of.
