2      17-09-2025                      Heard Mr. Nagendra Upadhyay, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Md. Nazir Ansari, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Sanjhauli P.S. Case No. 51/2025 registered for the offence(s) punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 303(2) and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, the petitioner with an intention to kill allegedly assaulted on the head of the son of the informant, causing injury.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submitted that due to some altercation at the time of Holi festival, the petitioner



assaulted the victim, who is the son of the informant. The injury sustained by the son of the informant is simple. Petitioner has clean antecedent

5. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. Having considered the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well, having perused the allegation made in the FIR and the injury being simple in nature, I am of the opinion that petitioner, who is having clean antecedent, has, *prima facie*, made out a case to be released on pre-arrest bail.

7. The petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned District Court within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate- III, Bikramganj (Rohtas) / Concerned Court in connection with Sanjhauli P.S. Case No. 51/2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

8. The learned District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner is involved in some other cases, as what has been



stated in paragraph no.3 of the bail application, this order will  
automatically lose its force.
