the petitioner and Mr. Satya Nand Shukla, learned APP for the
State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection
with Derni P.S. Case No. 223 of 2019 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 379, 411 and 414 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. The case of the prosecution is that one Sanjay
Sharma has disclosed to the police that he has sold a stolen bike
to this petitioner in Rs. 6,000/-

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has
committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from his possession. His name



has surfaced in the statement of co-accused Sanjay Sharma. It has also been submitted that petitioner has been framed in this case due to his criminal antecedent. From perusal of the F.I.R., it is clear that save and except the statement of Sanjay Sharma, there is nothing against the petitioner. He is languishing in judicial custody since 06.05.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the application for bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chapra, Saran in connection with Derni P.S. Case No. 223 of 2019.
