ORAL ORDER

2 03-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Parsa
P.S. Case No. 187 of 2025 instituted for the offences punishable
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 125 litres
of liquor has been recovered from TVS Scooty.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No
incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got no concern
with the alleged recovery of liquor. The name of the petitioner
has transpired in this case on the basis of the disclosures made



by the co-accused Imran Alam. The petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2025 and has one criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner again submits that the co-accused namely Imran Alam @ Ibran Alam has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 51122 of 2025.

6. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Parsa P.S. Case No. 187 of 2025.
