2 04-02-2025 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well

as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Cheria Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 40 of 2024 for the
offences punishable under Sections 307/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per allegation, the informant along with his sons
on a Scorpio vehicle was returning to home from the chimney
and in the way, the accused persons including the petitioner
started chasing and firing upon them with intention to kill.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. None has suffered any kind of injuries in the alleged



occurrence. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He has also submitted that on exactly similar footing, co-accused Sanjay Sah @ Sanjay Kumar has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 20.09.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 60969 of 2024.

5. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Manjhaul, Begusarai in connection with Cheria Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 40 of 2024, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the Court.
