3 04-04-2025 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 16851 of 2015, which has stood dismissed for non-prosecution, vide order dated 14.9.2023.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the counsel for the petitioner was engaged in another Court, he could not appear when the case was called out for hearing, hence, the aforesaid writ petition was dismissed for non-prosecution, thus a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ petition be restored to its original file.
