ORAL ORDER

3 01-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Gwalpara (Arar O.P.) P.S. Case No. 225 of 2023 dated 26.11.2023 registered for the offence punishable u/s 392 of the I.P.C

3. As per the prosecution case, on 24.11.2023 at about 11:02 P.M., a bag containing cash of Rs. 13,90,000/- was being carried by one Alok Kumar (employee of H.D.F.C. Bank, Madhepura). In the meantime, two unknown miscreants intercepted him and at the gunpoint took away the said bag.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and during



course of the investigation his name has transpired in this case. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has twenty one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 13.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Madhepura, in connection with Gwalpara (Arar O.P.) P.S. Case No. 225 of 2023, with a condition;-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
