3 23-09-2025 In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(i) Quashing of the time barred decision dated 29.10.2024 as contained in Memo No. 803 (Annexure P/10) to the extent, the Respondents have decided to proceed afresh against the petitioner in purported compliance of the order passed by this



Hon'ble Court on 19.05.2023;

- (ii) Quashing of consequential time barred Notice to Show Cause as contained in Letter No. 846 dated 19.11.2024 (Annexure P/11) by which, the Registering Authority, even after expiry of the registration has directed the petitioner to respond within a fortnight as to why for the allegation of submitting False Experience Certificate, the Registration No. MWRD1219C2PR0895 Class 2 be not blacklisted in terms of the relevant provisions of the Bihar Contractor Registration Rules, 2007;*
- (iii) Restraining from giving effect to Notice to Show Cause as contained in Letter No. 846 dated 19.11.2024 during the pendency of the present writ application and/or the without the leave of this Hon'ble Court.”*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner is relying on identical matter decided by this Bench on 09.09.2025 in C.W.J.C. No.12231 of 2025 to the extent that the decision is aptly applicable to the case in hand. It is not disputed by the learned counsel for the respondents.

3. Accordingly, instant writ petition stands allowed in the light of the order dated 09.09.2025 passed in C.W.J.C. No.12231 of 2025 and the impugned Show Cause Notice dated



19.11.2024 (Annexure-P/11) is set aside.

4. CWJC No. 15036 of 2025 allowed.
