2 25-09-2025 Heard Mr. Ram Prawesh Kumar, learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Arun Kumar,
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Sadar P.S. Case No. 268 of 2025 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2022.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, 86 litres of
foreign liquor was recovered from the house of co-accused Golu
Kumar Das.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has been
falsely implicated in the case. He has no concern either with the
seized liquor or trade of liquor in any manner. Total 86 litres of



foreign liquor was recovered from the house of co-accused Golu Kumar Das. The name of petitioner has been disclosed by one apprehended co-accused namely Vishal Kumar and the petitioner has denied his complicity in the alleged offence. The other accused namely Lalan Kumar has been granted bail by the this Court *vide* order dated 24.09.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No.63361 of 2025. On these grounds, petitioner seeks to be released on pre-arrest bail.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned District Court within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District Court where the case is pending in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 268 of 2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner is involved in some other cases as what has



**been stated in Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will
automatically lose its force.**
