3 19-03-2025 Heard Mr. Ranjan Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner; Mr. Md. Nadim Seraj along with Mr. Nirmal Kumar, learned counsels appearing on behalf of L.N.M. University and Mr. Madhaw Prasad Yadaw, learned GP 23 along with Ms. Meera Singh, learned AC to GP 23 for the State.

2. Mr. Nadim Seraj, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Lalit Narayan Mithila University informs that the petitioner has been informed that the total amount of Rs.20,32,245/- has been calculated under the different heads to be paid to the petitioner and soon the fund, which has been



sanctioned amounting to rupees about more than Rs.34 crore, is credited into the account of the University, the payment will be made to the petitioner.
