ORAL ORDER

2 24-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with Paharpur P.S. Case No. 175 of 2025 instituted for the offence under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 329(4), 303(2), 352 & 74 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that on 09.04.2025 at 6:00 P.M., petitioner No.1 ordered to kill the informant, tore her clothes with ill intention, assaulted her and snatched Rs. 3500/- and her gold mangalsutra, while petitioner No.2 attacked her with a *gadasa* on the head causing bleeding injury.



4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are in custody since 12.04.2025. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioners' counsel that petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that injury is found to be simple in nature, which falsify the allegation levelled against the petitioners. Learned counsel submits that both parties are agnates. There is delay of one day in lodging the FIR. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioners and injury being found to be simple in nature, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

8. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Paharpur P.S. Case
