2 24-09-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 191(2), 190, 303(2), 109 and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that 14 F.I.R. named accused persons, including these petitioners along with 15 to 20 unknown persons, assaulted son of informant and



snatched cash of Rs. 5,000/- and mobile phone.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and no specific accusation of overt act has been alleged against these petitioners. Doctor has opined the injuries, sustained by the injured, as simple in nature. Petitioners claim clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, general and omnibus nature of accusation, nature of injuries sustained by the injured and clean antecedents of the petitioners, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Gaya in



connection with Bodhgaya P.S. Case No. 182 of 2025, subject
to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..
