2. The present writ petition is disposed of granting

liberty to the petitioner to make a suitable representation

ventilating his grievance before the Principal Secretary (i.e., the

respondent No. 1 herein) within a period of four week from

today. On such representation being made, the authority shall

consider the same and pass necessary orders for correction of

the E-POS Machine. In case the claim of the petitioner is found



genuine, the authority shall pass necessary orders for rectifying the discrepancy in the E-POS Machine. The entire exercise shall be completed as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a representation by the petitioner. Any orders passed shall be communicated to the petitioner.

3. With the above direction, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
