2 24-09-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, on 15.05.2025, all the F.I.R. named accused persons, including these petitioners, armed with *Garasa* and *Danda*, assaulted informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on



behalf of the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. As a matter of fact, on account of petty dispute over drainage, scuffle took place between the parties. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and no specific accusation of overt act has been alleged against these petitioners. Doctor has opined the injuries, sustained by the injured, as simple in nature. Petitioners claim clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, general and omnibus nature of accusation, nature of injuries sustained by the injured and clean antecedents of the petitioners, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Danapur, Patna in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 195 of



2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of
the B.N.S.S..
