State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109 and
352 of the B.N.S.

3. As per the FIR, this petitioner assaulted the
informant and his son.

4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged.
Injury, allegedly, caused by this petitioner is simple in nature.
Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for
bail.

6. Considering the nature of injury, clean antecedent



of the petitioner and other circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within eight weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Masaurhi in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 245 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down under section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
