2 21-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. This petition has been filed for modification of order dated 28.07.2023, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3997/2023 to the extent of extension of time period to refund the amount fixed, to opposite party no. 2 of the said case, as directed in the aforesaid order as well as period of surrender.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to reasons assigned in the modification petition, petitioner was unable to comply with the direction of Hon'ble Court *vide* order dated 28.07.2023 and could not refund the alleged amount of Rs. 9 lacs to the opposite party no. 2 of the said case as such, he prays for further time to refund the aforesaid amount.



4. In view of the aforesaid contention made on behalf of the petitioner, further six weeks' time from today is granted to the petitioner to surrender and furnish bail-bond before the concerned Court where the case is pending, subject to deposit of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) in the office of concerned District Legal Services Authority and to furnish its receipt with the bail-bond with further condition to pay Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rs. Nine Lacs) to the opposite party no. 2 of the aforesaid case through bank draft within nine months from today, failing which learned court below would be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond.

5. The aforesaid amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) may be utilized by the Civil Court concerned in purchase of furniture and beautification of the court premises.

6. Accordingly, said order is modified to the extent indicated above.

7. This modification petition stands allowed.
