2 24-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from the orchard of this petitioner, altogether 40 liters of country made liquor was recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. He has got no concern with the alleged recovery. The recovery is from an open place. Nothing has been recovered from his possession. He is having no



criminal antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 29.07.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 414 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 01, East Champaram at Motihari.
