by other co-accused persons. Petitioner is neither seller, purchaser nor beneficiary to the sale deed in question . Moreover, the dispute involved in this case is purely of civil nature . Petitioner claims clean antecedent

5 . Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts, clean antecedent of petitioner and other circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest/surrender before the Court below within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned JM – Ist Gopalganj in connection with Gopalganj (Town) P.S. Case No. 443 of 2016, subject to condition as laid down under Section Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. 2023 .
