**ORAL ORDER**

2      07-10-2025                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State .

2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126 ( 2 ), 115 ( 2 ), 118 (1) , 109, 303 ( 2 ), 352, 351 ( 2 ), 351 (3) and 3 (5) of BNS.

3 . As per prosecution case , informant namely Md. Sarfaraj alleged that on 27.07.2025 at about 10:30 O ‘ Clock , all the F.I.R. named accused persons including these petitioners armed with iron rod, iron pipe , sword came and started



assaulting family members of informant. Petitioner Nos. 1 and 4 assaulted brother of informant with iron rod and petitioner No. 3 ( *Md. Arif* ) assaulted brother of informant with sword due to which he sustained injury . It is further alleged that accused persons took away Rs. 30,000/- and ornaments and also threatened with dire consequences.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that both the parties are gotias and due to land dispute , a maarpeet took place between them in which both sides sustained injuries. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus against petitioner Nos. 1 , 2 and 4. Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

5 . Learned counsel for the State as well as informant opposed the bail application and submits that petitioner No. 3 assaulted brother of informant with sword, as a result of which he sustained fracture injury .

6. In view of the fact that petitioner No. 3 caused fracture injury, **prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner No. 3 is refused.** However, considering the nature of accusation against petitioner Nos. 1, 2 & 4 the **anticipatory bail with regard to petitioner Nos. 1, 2 & 4 is allowed** and it is ordered that the above named petitioner Nos. 1, 2 & 4 in the event of



their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM Pupri at Sitamarhi in connection with Nanpur P. S. Case No. 306 of 2025 , subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 .
