ORAL ORDER

4 18-07-2025 At the outset, the learned counsel for the opposite parties submits that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 01.09.2022, passed by this Court in CWJC No.6182 of 2022, the District Magistrate, Khagaria has already passed a reasoned order dated 14.01.2023 whereby and whereunder the petitioner has been granted licence pertaining to NP Bore rifle, hence it is submitted that the order of this Court has stood complied with.
