2. On such complaint being filed, the authority concerned shall consider the same on its own merit duly putting



all the parties on notice and giving them an opportunity of hearing. Any order passed shall be communicated to the parties. The entire process to be completed as expeditiously as possible within a period of 12 weeks from the date of filing of the complaint by the petitioner.

3. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
