3. In this case, the petitioner (differently abled
person) seeks direction upon the police authorities for protection
of his life and property and also restrain the anti-social elements



from interfering with his property.

4. From perusal of the record of the case, it appears that there is a private dispute between the petitioner and the respondent nos.4 to 7 and in my opinion, this writ application is not maintainable.

5. Accordingly, this criminal writ application is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the District Court under appropriate jurisdiction.
