ORAL ORDER

2 18-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 312 of 2025 dated 19.04.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 137(2) and 96 of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant by enticing her.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the victim has been recovered and her statement has been recorded u/s 183 of the B.N.S.S., there was love affair between the victim and the petitioner. The charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. The petitioner has no



concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 01.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner and submitted that the victim is minor girl.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Patna in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 312 of 2025, with the condition :-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
