4 09-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.

2. The petitioner, husband of opposite party no. 2,
apprehends his arrest in a complaint case punishable for the
offence under Sections 498(A), 406, 420, 323, 379, 120(b) of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 3, 4 of the Dowry Prohibition
Act.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner
submits that the dispute between the parties has been settled
amicably through the process of mediation and for this, the
petitioner offered to pay **Rs. 7,50,000/-** (Rupees seven lacs fifty



thousand) in installments, as full and final settlement amount and opposite party no. 2 has accepted the offer and gave her consent.

4. Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 does not dispute and confirms the fact regarding settlement entered into between the parties.

5. Here, it is relevant to mention that earlier, with consent of the parties, the matter was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties, which has been resolved in terms of Memorandum of Agreement annexed with Mediator's report.

6. Considering the fact that dispute between the parties has been resolved, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner is allowed.

7. Let the petitioner, as named above, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs.10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Gopalganj in connection with Tr. No. 2053 of 2024, arising out of Complaint Case No. 436 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of



the Code of Criminal Procedure with further condition that
*petitioner shall abide by all the terms & conditions,
mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement, failing which,
learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond
of the petitioner.*
