2 15-10-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with Benipatti P.S. Case No. 270 of 2025 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The recovery is of 90 liters of illicit liquor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner are innocent and they are in custody since 28.08.2025.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to donate Rs. 20,000/- each in some charitable organization without accepting their guilt.

6. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for bail of the petitioners.

7. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned Court below in connection with Benipatti P.S. Case No. 270 of 2025.

8. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioners shall deposit an amount of Rs. 20,000/- each in Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Bela, Muzaffarpur and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioners.

9. As a condition of this order, the petitioner after being released on bail is directed to mark his attendance at Benipatti Police Station on every Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the police station will result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.
