2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2022.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from a Bolero Vehicle, altogether 900 liters of country made liquor was recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in connection with the present case. It is further contended that petitioner is the only driver of said vehicle. He was no knowledge about the alleged illicit liquor. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 01.09.2025



having no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Hajipur Sadar (Kajipur) P.S. Case No. 696 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1 cum District and Additional Sessions Judge, Vaishali at Hajipur.
