In case the authorities are of the opinion that any clarification is needed, they shall put the petitioner on notice and give him an opportunity of clarifying the queries raised by them. The entire exercise shall be completed as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Any order passed shall be communicated to the petitioner.

3. With the above direction, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
