A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 302, 201 and 34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, informant suspects that
some unknown persons committed murder of her husband.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence.
Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.. Name of petitioner
transpired in this case during course of investigation merely on
the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Mahesh
Kumar. Save and except confessional statement, there is no
material on record to show the complicity of this petitioner in



the alleged occurrence. No motive has been assigned for the petitioner getting involved in the alleged occurrence. Similarly situated co-accused person, namely Manish Kumar, who was also named during course of investigation in the confessional statement of co-accused Mahesh Kumar, has already been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 06.05.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 27390 of 2025. Moreover, charge-sheet has already been submitted and petitioner, having no criminal antecedents, is in custody since 28.06.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, general and omnibus nature of accusation, period of custody, claim based on parity and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant bail of to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dalsingsarai, Samastipur in connection with Ujiarpur P.S. Case
