02. In the present case, the petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 291 of 2024, registered for the alleged offences under Section 309(4) and later on added Sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(4), 303(2), 317(2), 212, 231 and 60 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

03. As per prosecution case, the petitioner, being working as RO of some micro finance company, embezzled an amount of Rs. 42,800/- and lodged a false report about he being looted by unknown miscreants who also took away the mobile phone and other articles from the petitioner.

04. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this



case. Petitioner has been made accused in this case merely due to fact that Rs. 33,490/- has been transferred by him in favour of his mother-in-law and Rs. 15,000/- to his own account and the petitioner lodged the case to defraud its employer. Learned counsel further submits that for embezzlement of Rs. 42,800/-, the petitioner is in custody since 04.08.2024 and at the request of Investigating Officer, the bank account of petitioner has been frozen. Charge-sheet has been submitted. The petitioner is having antecedent of one case.

05. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

06. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the parties and considering the period of custody of the petitioner along with submission of charge-sheet, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Darbhanga in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 291 of 2024, subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) of the Cr.P.C. and the following conditions:

(i) One of the bailors will be a close relative of



the petitioner.

(ii) The petitioner will remain present on each and every date fixed by the court below.

(iii) In case of absence on three consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, the bail bond of the petitioner will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
