ORAL ORDER

2 30-10-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Dalsingsarai P.S. Case No. 407 of 2023 instituted for the offence
under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution story in short is that while the
informant – who runs a jewellery shop – was on his way back
after closing his shop, two persons riding a motorcycle chased
him and overtook his motorcycle and thereafter, snatched away
250 gm of silver and cash worth Rs. 8000/- and some other
articles.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 09.06.2025. Petitioner



bears twelve criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Gopal Choudhary. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner was not even put on T.I.P. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case. Other co-accused have been granted bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, vide orders dated 04.03.2025 & 22.04.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 82828 of 2024 and Cr. Misc. No. 87754 of 2024, respectively.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, claim based on parity and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court



below/concerned Court in connection with Dalsingsarai P.S.
Case No. 407 of 2023, subject to the following conditions:

- (I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.
- (II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
