APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Manuapool P.S. Case No. 3 of 2025 instituted for the offences under Sections 317(4), 317(5), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that police apprehended two persons, Sudhan Kumar and Sibhu Kumar (petitioner), while they were riding stolen motorcycles and recovered two bikes and mobile phones from their possession. Both accused confessed to stealing and selling motorcycles after tampering with their number plates and chassis numbers.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the recovered motorcycles. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2025 and has six criminal antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Manuapool P.S. Case No. 3 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
