“I. For issuance of an appropriate writ order(s)/ direction(s) in the nature of mandamus for a direction to the concerned respondents particularly to the respondent nos. 4, 5 and 6 to stop the illegal encroachment on the land of the playground/ park, belonging to Jagarnath High



School, Barh and immediately handover the peaceful physical possession of the said land on which the playground/park of the school exists to the management of the said School to be utilized by the Students of the said school for their education and recreation activities.

II. And for issuance of any other relief or relief(s) for which the petitioner is entitled for.”
