2 18-01-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State .

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 21, 22 of the Narcotic
Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

3 . As per prosecution case, 43 litre illicit cough syrup
was recovered from the spot, and all the accused persons
including this petitioner are alleged to have fled away from the
place of occurrence .

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case only on the
basis of suspicion and no incriminating material has been
recovered from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is neither
driver nor owner of the vehicle in question . Similarly situated



co-accused person has already granted bail by this Court vide order dated 11.09.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 57013 of 2024 .

5 . Considering the fact that similarly situated co-accused person has already granted bail by this Court and circumstances of the case and clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, NDPS Act, Araria in connection with Jogbani P. S. Case No. 98 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
