3 28-11-2025 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 233 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, in course of returning from Chandi Asthan after worshipping, on the way, some unknown miscreants intercepted the informant and looted his motorcycle and ATM card at gunpoint.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that, as per report of the test identification parade (TIP), the informant did not identify the



petitioner. Nothing was recovered from possession of the petitioner and except some criminal cases, there is nothing against him.

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate Sherghari, Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 233 of 2021, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
