3 10-01-2025 Heard Mr.Ram Shankar Prasad, learned counsel for
the petitioner and Mr.Dr. Ajeet Kumar, learned A.P.P. for the
State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail, who is in custody since
22.04.2024 in connection with Goraul P.S. Case No. 283 of
2023, F.I.R. dated 01.07.2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code
and 3/4 of D.P.Act.

3. Allegation against the petitioner is that he
alongwith other co-accused persons have in furtherance of their
common intention committed the dowry death of the daughter
of the informant.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner has clean antecedent. He has falsely



been implicated in the present case merely on the ground that the petitioner is husband of the deceased. The allegation as alleged in the FIR is false and fabricated and the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR and from a bare perusal of the FIR it appears that there is no specific allegation of any assault, overt-act or demand of dowry attributed against the petitioner rather there is general and omnibus allegation against all the accused persons including the petitioner.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is husband of the deceased.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in connection with Goraul P.S. Case No. 283 of 2023 pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur.

7. Prayer is refused.

8. However, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge, if so advised.
