The respondent no.5 is directed to consider the case of the petitioner after affording opportunity of personal hearing and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation, especially considering the grievance as raised in para-7 of this writ application and, if any amount is accrued in favour of the petitioner, the same shall must be paid to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

4. It is made clear that respondent no.5 shall be solely liable for non-compliance of this order within the stipulated period.

5. With the aforesaid direction, this writ application stands disposed of.
