the petitioner and Mr. Prem Kumar Jha, learned APP for the

State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Chhapra Mufassil P.S. Case No. 509 of 2018 dated
26.11.2018 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 363 and 366/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The main submissions advanced by the petitioner's
counsel are that the petitioner has fair and clean antecedent, the
main allegation is against three co-accused persons namely,
Sonu Kumar Giri, Md. Junaid Alam and Irfan Alam who tried to
kidnap the victim but were apprehended at the spot by the
informant and his co-villagers and petitioner's role was not
alleged in that main part of the occurrence. It is further



submitted that the petitioner has been made accused mainly on account of the disclosure made by the apprehended co-accused persons except this there is nothing against him. It is lastly submitted that the victim girl did not disclose the name of the petitioner in her statement recorded under Section 183 of BNSS.

4. Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. In the facts and circumstances of this case and considering the above submissions, this Court is of the view that it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, let the petitioner named-above, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court concerned in connection with Chhapra Mufassil P.S. Case No. 509 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
