4 14-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 24.06.2024 passed in CWJC No. 14986 of 2011.

3. Learned counsel for the State has filed a show cause on behalf of the Opposite Party No. 5 stating therein that in compliance of the order dated 24.06.2024 passed in CWJC No. 14986 of 2011, the authority has passed a reasoned and



detailed order considering all the aspects including the case of the similarly situated person, namely, Phudan Prasad Gupta. So the opposite parties have complied the order of this Hon’ble Court.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the opposite parties has not complied the order of this Hon’ble Court in true spirit.
