2. Learned counsel for the Mines and Minerals
Department submits that the Mines and Minerals Department
has filed a letter dated 02.01.2025 issued by the In-charge,
Mines and Minerals Development Officer, Begusarai which

25.10.2024 and has passed a fresh order dated 02.01.2025.
