The present writ petition has been filed for direction upon the authority concerned for refund of Rs. 2,59,400/- which he has deposited on 13.06.2023 as a compounding fee and fine for compounding in compliance of the letter No. 776 dated 13.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) and it appears from the pleading that the petitioners had deposited the same and after depositing the amount
