2 07-01-2025 The limited prayer made by the petitioner in the present case is to direct the District Magistrate, Saharsa, to dispose of the application filed by the petitioner for grant of arms license on 30.6.2021.

2. *Per contra*, the learned counsel for the Respondent-State submits that in case, the petitioner has filed an application for grant of arms license and the same is still pending, it shall be disposed off, within a fixed time frame.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the District Magistrate,
