4 27-06-2025 The Superintendent of Police, West Champaran has submitted a show cause explaining the steps taken by the District Police Administration to comply with the order passed



by this Court in CWJC No. 686 of 2023. It is found from the show cause show by the Superintendent of Police that the previous investigation officer has already been removed and one S.I. of Police with 5 members, Special Investigation Team headed by S.D.P.O. Sadar-I, Bettiah was constituted for recovery of the missing person.
