3 14-11-2025 Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed this Court that the order of which contempt has been alleged was an interim order, later on final order was passed by learned Writ Court which was subject matter of challenge in LPA No. 626 of 2024. The said LPA has been allowed and the writ application



has been remanded to the learned Single Judge for consideration.

2. In the aforesaid view of the matter, this Court is of the considered opinion that the interim order which merged into the final order in the writ application would not survive.

3. The contempt application has become infructuous and is being disposed of accordingly.
